	applied by 31st January 2024, you should receive a
	decision by 16 th May 2024. If you have applied
	between 1st February – 30th June 2024 you should
	receive a decision by 17 th July 2024. Applications
	received from 1st July 2024 onwards will be notified of
	a decision by mid-August 2024.

Can I arrange my own clinical practice	No. Placements are arranged in agreement with the	
learning experiences?	clinical area by the Department of Nursing to ensure	
	you meet all requirements of the NMC. You may not be	
	able to get all these experiences in certain areas so	
	should expect to travel or stay away at times.	
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	During clinical placements you should not work any more than 10 hours per week in any other capacity – this is an EU Directive (the legal limit for total hours worked is 48 hrs per week averaged over a period of weeks).
