## What you need:

- 30 cm ruler
- A willing volunteer



## What you do:

- Hold the ruler at the 30 cm end so that it dangles downwards.
- Your volunteer should place their thumb and first finger together then open them about 2 cm to make a pincer.
- Ask your volunteer to place their 'pincer' either side of the bottom of the ruler ( 0 cm mark).
- Drop the ruler but do not give the volunteer any warning.
- Look at where they caught the ruler and read off the number of centimetres next to their fingers.

| Measurement | Rating |
| :--- | :--- |
| Less than 1 cm | Cheating! |
| 2 to 8 cm | Fantastic |
| 8 to 15 cm | Excellent |
| 15 to 20 cm | Good |
| 20 to 27 cm | Average |
| 27 to 30 cm | Fair |
| Did not catch ruler | Slow |

## The Science

Your reaction time is the time it takes your brain to respond to something. In this case how long it takes your brain to respond by closing your fingers after you have seen the ruler drop. Reaction times can be affected by lots of things including; how old you are, if you are tired or if you are distracted.
