

## **UB711003 Clinical Reasoning, Judgement and Decision Making**

**SCQF Level 11:** Credits 20

**Module Length:** 15 weeks

**Semester:** Autumn

### **Learning Outcomes**

- Critically appraise theories of thinking and decision-making informed by cognitive psychological approaches.
- Evaluate approaches to measurement and interpretation of clinical and diagnostic information and apply this to their own context of practice.
- Critically analyse and evaluate the theory and interpretation of evidence-based practice and apply this to their own context of practice.
- Demonstrate application of their knowledge and critical understanding of the active process of clinical reasoning, judgement and decision-making related to an episode of patient care from their own context of practice.
- Demonstrate critical awareness of the potential for intrinsic and extrinsic factors to affect clinical decision making.

### **Mode of Study**

Part-time (Structured): This module is studied through supported online learning via the university's virtual learning environment (VLE) with 3 face-to-face learning days and two assessment drop-in sessions.
