Learning outcomes

- Critically examine the personal and professional qualities and attributes that foster resilience and authentic leadership in self and others.
- Critically evaluate leadership approaches and the related evidence base that is used to inform and support effective delivery of health and social care services.
- Critically analyse factors which influence and impact on leadership within organisational cultures.
- Critically evaluate the components of healthcare leadership models and make informed judgements about their potential to support professional leadership approaches for practice within health and social care settings.

Mode of study

Part-time (Structured): A blended approach will be adopted for teaching and learning using the university's virtual learning environment (VLE), along with two face-to-face sessions for interactive learning either at the Department of Nursing (Inverness) or Western Isles (Stornoway), or via video conferencing.
