Learning outcomes

- Determine and justify outcomes of clinical assessments of capacity in relation to consent to healthcare treatments.
- Critically review and reflect on the implementation of principles-based legislation in the context of person centred and human rights-based care.
- Critically review and evaluate options for maximising participation in decision making for people with cognitive and/or communication impairments.
- Synthesise a range of assessment information and recommend the appropriate legislative framework for support and protecting adults at risk of harm.

Mode of study
