Difficulty in detecting when work is written by humans or Al

Serious limitations with what it can generate, references are "generated" but are not legitimate.

Find the fine line between Helping a student to complete their own work and completing the work for them.

THINK OUTSIDE THE BOX

- Can uncover previously unknown information
- Suggest unique themes, colour schemes etc outside of normal boundaries
- Can generate lists and lists of ideas at significant pace
- Logical doesn't always look lovely!









