
We are a not-for-profit membership organisation, owned by the sectors we serve.

Apprenticeship Toolkit






Jisc Collections (HE)




Geospatial Service





Building Digital Capabilites Discovery Tool





The Digital discovery tool

It is:

- A self-administered quiz for staff and students (not available free of charge for students) about digital practices (in education)
- Designed to give useful feedback including 'next steps' and links to resources
- Reflective, informative and developmental

It is not:

- An objective measure of digital performance
- Designed to provide detailed data about what staff can/cannot do (see tracker)
- A complete learning resource or course of study
